# Barbershoppers bring harmony to Emerald Coast

The Emerald Coast Chorus will bring harmony to the Emerald Coast with their annual show at 7:30 p.m. Friday at the Emerald Coast Convention Center on Okaloosa Island.

This year's show is titled "I Believe in Music," which also is the 2012 theme for the International Barbershop Harmony Society, a worldwide organization of barbershop harmony singers, headquartered in Nashville, Tenn.

Tickets are \$15 in advance and \$20 at the door. There are a limited number

of student tickets for \$10

Tickets are also available at these local outlets: P.S. Gifts in Fort Walton Beach, Destin Cat Clinic in Destin, Connect with Flowers in Shalimar, Bayou Books in Niceville, and at Friendly Florist in Crestview.

The Emerald Coast Chorus is a local barbershop chorus that has been singing in the area for more than 35 years. The chorus is composed of 40 men ranging in age from 15 to over 80.

The chorus will perform

their own music in the first half of the show. Several local schools have been invited to participate in this half of the show as well.

They are Chanticleer Chorus from Crestview High School, the Rocky Bayou School Chamber Choir, and Camerata from Niceville High School.

The schools will sing two songs each, and then they will join the Emerald Coast Chorus on stage for a patriotic medley. This is highlighted by a presentation of flags by the Choctawhatchee High School Air Force JROTC color guard.

Every year, many audience members request one special barbershop number called "Lida Rose" from the Broadway hit show, "Music Man."

The song will be included in the show, but with a

special added bonus. Renowned local soprano Sarah Lambert will join the chorus on stage to sing the solo made famous by Florence

Henderson in the movie adaptation of the show.

After a 15-minute intermission, the second half of the show will be provided

by guest quartet OC Times. OC Times is the 2008 international barbershop champion quartet.

Hailing from Orange County, Calif., are Shawn York (tenor), Sean Devine (lead), Pat Claypool (baritone) and Cory Hunt (bass).

They will perform their special brand of comedy and blended harmonies as they have all over the country since their award-winning competition in 2008.

The entire show should last about two hours, organizers said. Non-alcoholic beverages will be available before the show and during intermission.

In 2011, nearly 1,000 barbershop fans attended the show.

The box office opens at 5 p.m. for ticket sales and will call. Doors open at 7 p.m.
